


How to print labels in Labcheck


1: Log Into LabCheck, https://labcheck.castrol.com




2: Enter your credentials, email and password, and click Login.

To get access to the LabCheck portal as a new user, please reach out to your Castrol representative or Technical Services engineer who can help you with this process.


3: On the Front page, click on Tools In the right-hand corner.




3: Select Print Labels / Stickers



4: Select number of labels per equipment and click Print Labels / Stickers






7: Press Print Labels / Stickers



- 8: Save the PDF that is created to your computer and print on the printer attached to your computer.
- 9: Add paper from sample bottle kit to printer
- 10: Press print
- 11: When the sample is taken, populate the fields Unit HRS, Oil Hrs, Sampling Date, Potential Top ups and update the lubricant If the Incorrect lubricant is in use.



12: Peel label of paper and attach to bottle
